Scholarship Application for Nevada County Farm Bureau (revised for 2018 scholarships)

Nevada County Farm Bureau Scholarship and CJ Rolph Memorial Scholarship

General Requirements

The Nevada County Farm Bureau is offering scholarships to graduating Nevada County high school students that have been active members of Nevada County 4-H, Nevada County Grange or a Nevada County FFA chapter. The scholarships are awarded annually based on community service, extracurricular activities, academic achievement and career goals. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required. **Only Agricultural college majors will be considered for scholarships.**

Special Requirements

- Applicant must be a student of Nevada Joint Union High School District with an expected graduation date of 2018.
- Must have been an active member of 4-H , FFA, or Grange **for 3 years during High School.**

Supporting Information

- **A completed NJUHS District scholarship application packet** along with an original resume. The resume must include a current list of leadership activities in 4-H, FFA or Grange activities, and a list of community service hours.
- **Or the following:**
An official high school transcript and two Letters of reference from someone other than family. The letters should provide information about the applicant's character, ability, community and leadership activities, and 4-H, FFA, or Grange participation. It is preferred one letter be from an instructor or project leader. The original resume should include a current list of leadership activities in, 4-H FFA or Grange and a list of community service including all Farm Bureau volunteer hours

(To be included in award letter)

This scholarship will be awarded under the following process: Please send an official college registration noting a declared major and list of classes by October 31st year in which the scholarship was awarded. This will be outlined in your award letter. **Failure to provide the official documentation as requested by October 31 of the year in which the scholarship is awarded will cause the scholarship to be forfeited.**

Renewal Instructions: This scholarship is renewable for 3 years. An application renewal letter and renewal application (*available on our website*) must be submitted to the Nevada County Farm Bureau by April 1st of the year following the award and funding of the scholarship. (If you receive the scholarship in 2018 then renewal must be applied for by 4/1/2019) **If no renewal application and letter is received by that due date then your scholarship will be considered fully funded and NO further funds will be paid.** The letter, to be included with the application, should update the NCFB Board of Directors on the student's activities and college experience, and include an official class list and declared major for the renewal year.
